Implement and maintain Lakehouse architecture in Fabric to support scalable, governed, and unified data storage and processing.
Data Analysis and Interpretation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Analyze large datasets using statistical methods, machine learning models, and data mining techniques to uncover actionable insights. Utilize Fabric Notebooks and Spark environments for advanced data exploration, modeling, and experimentation. Translate business requirements into analytical tasks and conduct exploratory data analysis using Fabric-integrated tools.
Reporting & Visualization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Develop and maintain interactive dashboards and reports using Power BI, integrated with Fabric's OneLake and Lakehouse for real-time analytics. Create ad-hoc and scheduled reports leveraging Direct Lake mode and semantic models to support strategic decision-making. Collaborate with stakeholders to ensure visualizations align with business goals and leverage Fabric's unified data foundation for consistency and governance.
