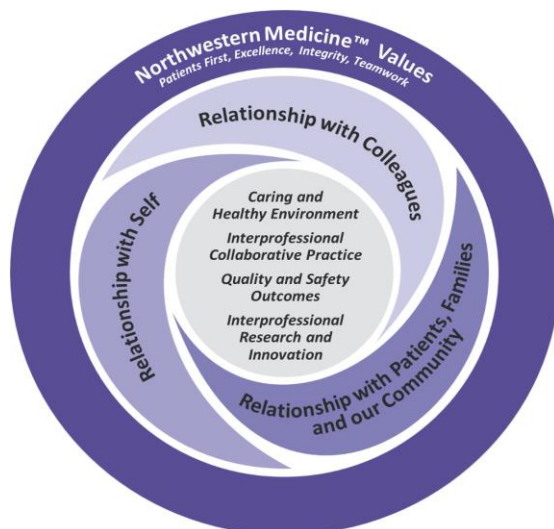
Transition into nursing practice with confidence
