The role

In this role you'll be using your electrical or mechanical background to ensure the smooth operation of our wind turbine generators.

Position accountabilities

- Supporting the wind farm's productivity by leading scheduled service and reactive maintenance on the site (which may involve the use of hydraulic torque and tensioning tools)
- Learning the turbine controls and systems
- Being a competent fault finder in both mechanical or electrical systems
- Maintaining all company vehicles and plant equipment to ensure good operating conditions
- Complying with the site's safety expectations by reporting all incidents, accidents, or near misses and undertaking each task in a manner that ensure you and those around you stay safe
- Having a high standard of workmanship and being a real team player

Position accountabilities continued

- Supporting the site's growth by sharing opportunities for continuous improvement
- Being available for on call duties as part of the team roster

Knowledge, experience and skills

- Registered electrician, or have an electrical trade qualification
- Trade qualified mechanical fitter
- Hydraulic engineer (trade)
- EAS/EST qualified technician
- Physically fit - able to climb up to 70 metres and lift up to 25kg
- Comfortable working in confined spaces, and – it goes without saying – at height!

- Any form of wind turbine experience
- Diagnostic or fault-finding experience (electrical or mechanical)
