1.0 Position Purpose

The Educator supports the Lead Educator to achieve the efficient and effective running of a child care room within the University Child Care Centre, and contributing to the education and development of children.

- To support the Lead Educator in meeting and implementing the various aspects of the day-to-day running of the 'Indoor/Outdoor' program.
- Work with other staff to achieve the Centre's 'Indoor/Outdoor' program objectives.
- Undertake all duties in accordance with the Centre's policy and procedure handbook.
- Observe all guidelines and regulations pertaining to the delivery of child care in child care centres whilst undertaking day-to-day activities.
- Support compliance with relevant legislation and University policies and procedures, including equity and health & safety and exhibit good practice in relation to same.
- Be a leading example of the principles and values embodied in the University's Code of Conduct, and behave, act and communicate at all times to reflect fairness, ethics and professionalism.
