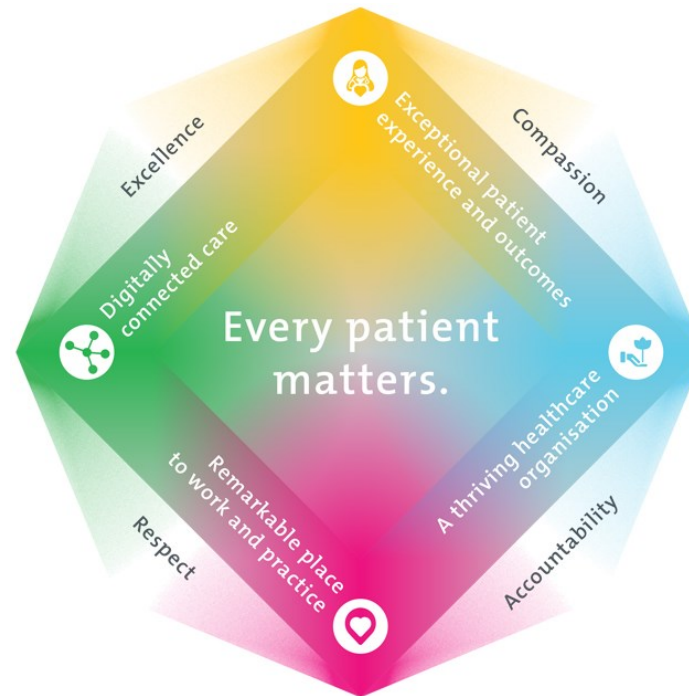
2. Overview of Epworth HealthCare

Administration/Administration Support	• Assist the Team Leader Administration to establish and maintain a departmental procedure manual. • Attend meetings on behalf of the department as required. • Produce computer reports as required. • Support patient admission and discharge processes, as required. • Prepare admission packs, collating and general administrative tasks as required. • Provide patients with Informed Financial Consent and ensure all appropriate paperwork has been signed by patient as part of the admission process, as required. • Receive & receipt patient payments as required. • Action all other general administrative tasks as required. • Demonstration of high-level communication skills with all members of the Health care team. • Participation in quality improvement processes. • Challenge and evaluate work practices and systems, identifying inefficiencies and participate in the implementation of change. • Liaise with and provide support to the Administration Team Leader and Outpatient Coordinators.
