Architectural Technician / Designer

The Architectural Technician / Designer is responsible for assisting with the development of fit for purpose architectural documentation, including concept, resource consent, building consent and construction documentation packages that meet the requirements of the Summerset Design teams and external stakeholders such as territorial authorities.
