Contribution / Responsibilities	 Care Centre residents Provide personal care to residents under the guidance and direction of the Registered Nurse. This includes assistance with all day to day needs of the residents, e.g. showering, meals, toileting, and assistance with other needs. Follow the requirements of each resident's lifestyle or advanced care plan in a way that is respectful, and focuses on creating the most enjoyable lifestyle that is possible for them. Work within a holistic care environment through the establishment of caring relationships with residents and their families, to enhance residents' mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being. Support the Diversional Therapist in the delivery of the activity programme and focus on creating an enjoyable and satisfying lifestyle for each resident according to individual's needs.
	 Create a good environment for residents, visitors and staff Work as part of a team to support creating an enjoyable and safe home for residents, and an environment that is welcoming and pleasant for their visitors.
	 Whole of Village Provide care assistance, including first aid response to the residents within the Care Centre, and provide care assistance to residents anywhere within the village including Villas, Apartments and Care Apartments as required.
	 Clinical practices, residents safety and well-being Follow Summerset policies and procedures, maintain records, promptly inform clinical and senior staff of any concerns about residents and act in a way that is professional and ethical. Other tasks and duties that would fall within responsibilities and skills of the role, at the request of the Care Centre Manager or Registered Nurse on duty. This may include cleaning and housekeeping/laundry tasks escorting residents and assisting with organised activities for residents
Health & Safety	Be a proactive contributor to ensuring the health & safety of our people, our customers, our contractors and our residents. This includes conforming to Summerset's safety culture expectations of an environment of zero-harm and compliance with health and safety policies and procedures.
