

Job Description

Diversional Therapist

The purpose of the role is to provide an activities programme to residents in the Care Centre that is meaningful and enjoyable for residents, which promotes dignity and independence through the development of individualised resident recreational plans.

There will be scheduled activities that you will organise, promote and run end to end, from planning, organising through to the final delivery of the event e.g. Grandparents Day.

Your key focus will be the Care Centre residents but there may be vulnerable residents in the Village that may like to participate in the activities programme.

This job description provides an overview of the responsibilities and tasks of the role. You may be required to perform job related tasks other than those specified

	Ensure the Care Centre Manager is kept up to date with residents' requirements for activities. Collaborate with the Activities Coordinator and other DT's so that all village activities could be extended to the village residents as well as the Care Centre residents as relevant
People Leadership (if applicable)	Manage and develop direct report(s), with full accountability for all aspects of their recruitment, coaching, performance, recognition, and remuneration review within the parameters of company delegations. Foster and develop an inclusive team culture that works effectively with other teams to support Summerset's goals.
Health & Safety	Be a proactive contributor to ensuring the health & safety of our people, our customers, our contractors and our residents. This includes conforming to Summerset's safety culture expectations of an environment of zero-harm and compliance with health and safety policies and procedures.
