Founded as Jiffy-tite Company in 1963, initially the main product was a quick connect-disconnect fluid coupler invented by Bob Zillig and sold to plastic injection-molding firms to reduce the time needed to change molds. In the 1980s, automobile manufacturers became interested in quick connect technology to improve the reliability and cost of fluid connections in their assembly plants. Led by Steve Zillig, son of Bob Zillig, Jiffy-tite became the world leader of highly engineered fluid connection parts and assemblies. In March 2016, the company was acquired by Oetiker Group and renamed to Oetiker NY, INC. (ONY).
